FROM THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MANAGER AND EMERGENCY SERVICES DIRECTOR

The rules and guidelines below are hereby effective immediately, and are subject to change without prior notice. Based on current information and clinical health expertise, individuals over the age of 65 and any individuals of any age with underlying health conditions are recommended to use extreme caution before deciding to participate in any outdoor activity and/or close proximity to others during the COVID-19 global pandemic. **These guidelines are in addition to, not in lieu of, previously established guidelines by the City of Costa Mesa.**

Golf Cart Use Guidelines:

- Carts will be prioritized for individuals who need special accommodations in compliance with ADA.
- Golf course single rider only (two riders from the same household permissible with proof of co-residency).
- Carts will be washed and sanitized after each single use, and one final time at the end of the day.
- No pencils, tees, scorecards or sand bottles shall be provided.
- Cart rental will occur at time of check-in for golf on a first-come, first-served basis, using a touch free credit/debit terminal. Cash will not be accepted.

Driving Range Guidelines:

- Range stations will be a minimum of 10 feet apart. There shall be no visitors.
- Bag racks will be removed from the range.
- Range balls will be machine picked, machine sanitized, soaked and washed after each use.
- Range baskets will be washed and sanitized after each use.
- Fixed rubber or plastic tees and other surfaces on each range pad shall be washed and sanitized after each use.
- Where possible, left-handed golfers shall be placed at range stations so that their backs are to right handed golfers rather than facing them.
- Range customers must wear masks while walking to or from their range station. Steps should be taken to stagger start times to avoid customers passing each other going to or from range stations.
- No sharing of equipment except for members of the same household. No club rentals will be allowed.
- Main entrance of the parking lot will serve as a check-in. Employees will only allow range customers on site if there is an available hitting bay. Golfers will not be allowed to enter without an available time and will be contacted if and when a hitting range becomes available.
- Specific check in window for range customers will be set with a touch free credit/debit transaction. Cash transactions will not be accepted.

Staff will be monitoring and enforcing the above guidelines. Failure to adhere to the guidelines will result in removal from the property to help ensure the protection of other players.

This pandemic is a fluid situation and developments evolve quickly. The health and safety of our guests, staff, and community is our top priority. Our team will continue to follow the recommendations from local, state, and national health and government organizations as they become available.
